Funding/Tuition

You need to determine whether you are an **EU** or **Non-EU Applicant**

EU Applicant

1. Ordinarily resident in the EU and received Full-Time Post-Primary Education and/or worked Full-Time in the EU for three of the five years immediately preceding admission to an Irish College
OR
2. Holds a valid passport from an EU member state, have received all Full-Time Post-Primary education in the EU
OR
3. Has official refugee status
OR
4. Granted humanitarian Leave to Remain in State, ordinarily resident in the EU for three of five years immediately before admission to Irish College

*For students under 23 years of age- the student's parents must also live in the EU member state for 3 of 5 years prior to Admission to Irish College

*****If none of the above apply, you are a Non-EU applicant and you will require a 4/C grade in English*****
