


## Google: London: IT, Software Eng and Digital Marketing Work Experience Day online

## Prime Work Experience

Deadline - 01/03/2021

CMS offer work experience opportunities to school/college students who may not previously have had the option and introduce them to the law and their practice areas.

As a founding member of PRIME – an alliance between law firms across the UK aimed at improving access to legal professions – CMS are focused on helping students to propel their law careers forward. You'll have the chance to develop your employability skills, to connect with other students and explore the possibilities a future in law could offer you.

Getting you up close and personal with lawyers and support staff, this programme gives you the experience you truly need. They'll open your mind up to all the possibilities by showing you what legal practice and support roles are all about.

### **Requirements:**

To be eligible you'll need to be in either Year 12 or Year 13. You must also meet two (or more) of the following criteria:

- Attend a non-fee-paying school.
- Be the first in your family to attend university.
- Be eligible for free school meals.

A number of places are also available on their work experience programme each year for direct applicants who do not meet these criteria.
