'Our LSE Discovery Sessions will introduce prospective students to the range of study options at LSE, student life and the application process.


The sessions will involve a short introductory presentation delivered by a member of the Student Marketing and Recruitment team, followed by the opportunity for attendees to submit their own questions.'
